

SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING
MONDAY DECEMBER 2, 2002 – 7:00 P. M.
CENTRAL TOWN HALL

Present: Mayor Harrison R. Holladay, Jr.; Council members: Mac Martin; David Donald; Stan Thompson; Joe Head; Frank Chaka; Gary White. Asst. Fire Chief Edward Reynolds; Police Chief Joe Gibbs; Administrator Herbert Thompson; Clerk Grace Towe.

Mayor Harrison R. Holladay, Jr. called the Special Called Council Meeting to order at 6:30 P. M. and rendered the invocation.

1. Authorize Administrator to employ B. P. Barber and Associates to perform smoke test and TV sewer lines from Davis Street to College Street. The footage is approximately 2300 feet and the main interest at this time is to find out the condition of this line and what the cost to repair it would be. After this is done it would give an example of what would be involved in the rest of the problem areas in town.

Administrator Herbert Thompson expressed his concern that the project could be done for approximately \$15,000 and the Town could hope to get started on the project much sooner than if we wait to see if grant dollars would be available. After discussion a motion was made by Joe Head and seconded by Mac Martin to allow Administrator Herbert Thompson to hire B. P. Barber and Associates to perform the work on Davis to College Street, not to exceed \$15,000. The vote was unanimous.

2. Create position of Part time Paid Fireman. The job description was presented and Councilman Stan Thompson proposed a change to the document to refer to the position as a Part time Safety/Fire Inspector for the Fire Department in lieu of "fireman". Councilman Thompson stated that there was nothing in the document that required the applicant to be a fireman although knowledge of firefighting would be an advantage. A motion was made by Stan Thompson and seconded by Frank Chaka to create the position Records/Safety Officer in the fire department and on page two the proposed description the phrase "fire inspector" be changed to "Safety fire inspector". Mayor Holladay called for the vote and the vote was unanimous.

There being no further business Mayor Holladay called for a motion to adjourn. The motion was made by Frank Chaka and seconded by Joe Head. The vote was unanimous.
