

Regular Council Meeting August 13, 1985

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the Revenue Sharing Hearing minutes of July 8, 1985 were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Henry Law to approve. Vote unanimous.

Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of July 8, 1985 were read. Motion by Frank Chaka, second by Harry Holladay to approve. Vote unanimous.

Minutes of the Special Called Meeting of July 12, 1985 were read. Motion by Henry Law, second by "Doc" Evatt to approve. Vote unanimous.

Old Business;

Henry Law---Discussion of First Assembly of God sewer situation. Request by Jay Cooper (for Mr. Leon Newman) requested that the church be allowed to put a septic tank in lieu of sewer trunk line being run. No motion was made, but informed that Mr. Newman would be required to provide sewer to the property.
