The Town Council met Thursday night, January 7, 1965, with the following attending: Mayor Wayne C. Kelley, Councilmen Glenn D. O'Bell, R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, Jerry B. Lesley, J.I. Martin and J.B. Herd. Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger paper was also present.

Mayor Kelley presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on raising the pay of the Supt. of Streets extra time from \$1.25 per to \$1.50 per hr. Mr. Busha made a motion that Mr. Head be paid \$1.50 per hr. for extra time with the Town. Mr. Martin Seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mayor Kelley stated that the Town vehicles had been insured with North American Ins. Co..

Mr. Martin made a motion that \$15.00 be paid by the Town for the Firemen Dues of the South Eastern Association of Fire Chiefs. Mr. Busha seconded, the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Herd announced that John Head had reported the old town truck was in need of repair. Mayor Kelley appointed Mr. Herd and Mr. Martin to get an estimate of cost on repairs and have Mr. Head to have the necessary work done on the truck.

Mr. Martin made a motion that letter's be sent to County Delegation, Congressman, President of Duke Power and others giving their support of the Town Council and Mayor in their future project for developement in the upper part of the count. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
