MINUTES -----

At the meeting of the Town Council held on January 8, 1951 at 7:00 P. M. the following were present: G. M. Perry; Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of police; Councilmembers, C. F. James, Calvin Rampey, T. A. Phillips, J. W. Wallace, Jr., Frank Abercrombie.

The meeting was called to order and Mr. Perry brought up the license for Duke Power Company. Mr. W. B. Ellis, Duke Power Supt. had called up about the license and said that other towns the size of Central had a license fee of \$25.00 to our \$50.00. They paid \$50.00 in 1950 but had always paid \$25.00 up until this time. Mr. T. A. Phillips said we ought to say in line with other towns. The councilmembers agreed to this so Mr. Phillips made a move that Duke Power Company pay \$25.00. The motion was 2nd by J. W. Wallace. All were in favor of this.

The taxes were then discussed and as soon as the auditor brings a copy of our delinquent taxes we are to turn them over to our lawyer.

Mr. Perry had the three street lights put in that were authorized at the last meeting.

The sewer was then discussed and Mr. J. T. Owens line was brought up. Mr. Perry suggested that we pay for 100 feet of 4" Terra Cota pipe if Mr. Owens would get the right of way for this line. Mr. Gaines then said to let Jim & Luke dig the ditch for 100 ft. since Mr. Owens was crippled. Calvin Rampey made a motion that the town do the above. C. F. James 2nd the motion. It was agreed upon by all.

Skating on main street was discussed and there is already an ordinance against it. They may skate on the street down by the school. Mr. Gaines will see everybody about skating on main street.

Stopping in front of the school was then discussed and Mr. Perry is going to see the Trustees and see what can be arranged about loading the school children at the side of the school house. The council members suggested that Mr. Gaines and Mr. Perry meet with the Trustees to discuss this matter.

Trash cans are scarce and everyone is wanting them. Every body will have to buy ~~KNACK~~ Their own trash cans because the town is not able to buy them.

The meeting then adjourned.
