January 9, 1961

The Town Council held their regular meeting Monday, January 9, 1961, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen, J.A. Cranford, J.J. Canup, R.A. Busha, C.B. Bryan, and W.J. Wilson, also Mr. Roy Golden and Milton Moser with the Water Dept. were present, Mrs. Maude Chapman with the Messenger and Chief Reams.

The minutes were read and approved after which Mr. Busha gave a report on the power line from the Filterplant to the creek, and said that he had talked with Duke Power Officials about taking over the line, but thought that it would be better for the Town to maintain it for the time being. The Council agreed that the trees and rubbish should be moved and a check be made on the power poles. The Council also agreed that new transformers should be put at the Filterplant.

Mr. Golden gave a report on the water and how much a new pump would cost.

A discussion was held on changing the ordinance of Business License. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the out of Town Plumbing & Heating license be cut from \$50.00 to \$25.00, also a dealer selling furniture, clothes, appliances or notions from a truck or car be cut from ~~\$50.00~~ to ~~\$25.00~~ per year. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council voted unanimously.

Mr. Cranford ~~made~~ suggested that someone talk with Mr. Dowling about keeping the Bank open one afternoon each week in order for people who work during the day to have time to do business at the Bank (preferably Thursday or Friday) Mr. Wilson 2nd the motion. The Council agreed.


