

Regular Council Meeting
January 9, 1989

Mayor pro-tem Chaka called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Mr. Harry Holladay.

Minutes of the December 12, 1988 and the Special called meeting of December 19, 1988 were read. After correction to add to First Reading Annexation Ordinance, "This the property of Claypool, Merck, Cothren (Kenneth), Spartan Foods, Leland Martin, Cothran (Jessie) and Marshall Buchanan and Barnwell Myers." Frank Chaka - Finance -- Gave the financial report noting that water loss was down. Excessive spending in fire department due to the replacement of lights, ballasts and labor for this.

Troy Porter - Recreation - Had meeting with Bobby Busha and he is to have meeting concerning possible soccer program. Need letter of appreciation to Ms. Bolick ready for Mayor and Council to sign.

Clarence Phillips - Water and Sewer - Discussed water pipe that we have on hand, suggested to sell and replace funds in trust account where dollars were extracted to purchase same. Concensus of council for Mr. Herbert Thompson to go ahead and sell.

Impact fee-- Need to analyze present policy.

Central Textile still causing problems with starch dumping in sewer. Need good documentation so that when confronting company, will have something to stand on. Ordinance book being updated.

Above ground gas tank installed.

Winter Municipal meeting in Columbia at Radison Hotel, March 22, and 23.

911 System being implemented. Will bid out Recreation bus again.


No further business, Mayor Pro-tem Chaka adjourned the meeting.
