January 11, 1982  
Regular Council Meeting

The Mayor called the meeting to order.  
The Clerk read the minutes of the regular November Meeting:  
Motion by Chaka, second by Gambrell to adopt-vote unanimous.  
The Clerk read the minutes of the November 30 Special Meeting:  
Motion by Chaka, second by Rampey to adopt-vote unanimous.

Council Reports

- Mr. Chaka-commended the Town on reducing the amount of lost water to 13%. He urged that the Town continue to carefully monitor the amount of water lost and to try to reduce the the losses to under 10%.
- Mr. Gambrell-presented the financial report. He noted the loan situation and the high personnel costs as related to 6 paydays in December.
- Mr. Rampey-presented the police report for December and the cumulative figures for the year. Mr. Rampey also noted that the Fire Department will work with the Council in providing necessary tables and chairs. Mr. Rampey also discussed the continuing problem of stray dogs.
- Mr. Evatt-discussed the gym policy-he noted that no one was authorized to use the gym except recreation teams. He also noted that if there is damage done to the gym through vandalism or break-ins that it should be investigated by the police and prosecuted. He also noted that there was a severe mud problem on Johnson Road-the Administrator was instructed to notify the State Highway Department.
- Mr. Porter-no report from his committee. He did, however express a desire to see the leaf machine back in operation. The Administrator assured him that it would be.

Auditor's Report

The Auditor's presented the completed audit for fiscal year 1981. There were no questions. Auditors stated that if there were questions that they would meet at any time.

Mr. Porter made two requests; A. That pressure reducing valves be placed on Highway 88 at the junction of Church and Pepper Street and in the vicinity of W. W. Boren-also that additional cut-off valves be placed on 18. Council asked that the Administrator have Engineers look into the matter.

B. Mr. Porter requested that the money to buy an equipment shed be used as soon as possible to cover the new backhoe, ditch witch, etc.
