

Regular Council Meeting  
January 11, 1987  
7:00 P. M.

Present: Mayor Alton Cumbie; Councilmen Clarence Phillips; Frank Chaka; "Doc" Evatt; Harry Holladay; Troy Porter (Mr. Law at work) Frank Cantrell; Brian Garner, The Messenger

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by "Doc" Evatt.

Minutes of the December 14, 1987 meeting were read. Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Phillips to accept as read. Vote unanimous.

Mayor Cumbie recommended that the Community Restitution Program be participated in by The Town of Central. Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Phillips to accept. Vote was unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Law at work. Police report was presented by Mayor Cumbie. Mayor noted that due to need the judges had been given one pager to be used by the judge on call. This cost of approximately \$27.00 per month from the regular budget.

Mr. Chaka---Presented the financial report---items on target. Noted that an extra line item should be added for next year to include any action on Christmas bonuses. This would leave true picture of salaries in report.

Mr. Porter--Recreation -- None

Mr. Phillips -- Noted that Pickens County Water and Sewer Authority assistance was on hold. No meeting held with East Clemson Water District due to snow. To meet at later date.

Mr. Porter suggested that due to water meters being covered with snow and no hope of clearing in several days, that last months reading be used as this months reading and any adjustment be made next month. Have stamp made and advise on card of action. Council agreed to this suggestion.

Mr. Evatt--Meeting with delegation on C-Funds cancelled due to snow.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Law at work.

Mayor Cumbie read letter concerning free rural fire fees. 17 names on list, these to be verified. Letter presented as motion to give free service. This to refine original motion. Motion by Mayor and seconded by Mr. Chaka to accept this letter. Noted that Fire District Meeting to be held January 19, 1988 at Edwards Jr. High School at 7:00 P. M. To be advertised in papers. Noted that council members need to attend.

Mr. Chaka---Finance---Noted that Revenue Sharing Public Hearing had been held. Motion by Mr. Chaka, seconded by Mr. Porter to spend funds as discussed and (attached) and give balance of fund to fire department. Vote was unanimous.

Mr. Porter - Recreation \_\_\_ Noted that Bobby Busha had been paid \$100.00 for work on the gym. Coaches dinner cost was \$200.00 paid to Holiday Inn for the banquet and cost of the jackets was \$425.00. Motion by Mr. Porter, second by Mr. Evatt to accept expended items and allot the excess \$125.00 from recreation account. The vote was unanimous.

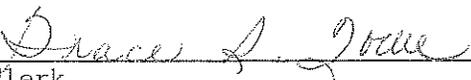
Mr. Phillips - Water and Sewer - Map presented concerning Pickens County Water and Sewer Authority franchise area. Discussion only.

Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Chaka to advertise for a consultant for Mini-Technical Grant administration. CDBG Resolution concerning Head Town submitted. Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Phillips to accept. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Evatt - Streets and Sanitation -- Maw Bridge sidewalk area discussed.

Mayor's report: Noted Recreation Commission to meet before next work session to review job descriptions.  
Winter Meeting of the Municipal Association to meet February 10 and 11, 1988 in Columbia. Motion by Mr. Evatt, second by Mr. Chaka to allow Mayor Cumbie the \$60.00 registration fee if he can attend. Vote unanimous.
