## Regular Council Meeting Jan. 12, 1976

Those Present: Mayor, Fowler, Hopkins, Kennemore, Porter, Busha, and Thompson; 2 gentlemen with Harwood Beebe Co. and Mr. E. L. Bolick

Mayor called the meeting to order and gave the floor to the 2 gentlemen from Harwood Beebe who gave an update report of our old Sewer lines; Pickens Co. 201 plant. Money for the evaluation will cost the Town Approx. \$71,000, in which a grant of 75% will be given (our cost \$17,500). Total actual repair work will cost Town \$31,700.

Mayor asked who would do the repairs? If we have the manpower we could probably do the work.

The Eng. Co. would spend 1/5 of the working time on the job. Hopkins asked what would happen if the leak was on the owners property? It is not eligible for funding but it would be the property owners job to fix this. Why must we go with project due to the extra rain water that goes into our system, we over run our EPA Permit Conditions.

Herbert Thompson asked what guarantee do we have of what % of inflation of removal could they guarantee us? They said about 75% removal.

Mayor Holliday read the ordinance for the administrator, 2nd reading in its entirety; discussion. Fowler made motion that we adopt the ordinance, 2nd by Busha.

Fire Dept.: Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins to honor any Fire Dept. in the County. Use proclamation same as Pickens.

Thompson made motion to ~~be~~<sup>buy</sup> Fire Dept. monitor, 2nd by Hopkins. We will place restrictions on the monitor. Council Carried.

Town business licenses over Cannon Mills, Mayor said he would like to see a ceiling of \$500.00 on business licenses: The recommendation died from lack of a motion to adopt the Mayor's proposal.

Thompson made motion for the Sewer Com. to take care of the water problem at the North Sewer Plant to buy a well pump also a pump to clean the plant with, 2nd by Busha, Motion Carried.

Police Chief asked what to do about old Plymouth Police Car. We will advertise for sealed bids. We have the right to refuse any or all bids. Motion by Porter, 2nd by Thompson. Motion Carried.

Fowler brought up about pipe that was bought for the ball field. George said the pipe was too high and he wanted to know who said to buy the pipe,

Chief Duncan also asked about a shot gun for the car with a holder. Council gave OK to buy this gun and rack.

Porter gave a report on buying a bus for the Recreation Dept. The bus would cost \$312.00. Fowler said the Lions Club had a bus for sell for about \$650 - 700. Thompson made motion for Fowler to buy the bus that the Lions Club has for sell. 2nd by Kennemore. Motion Carried.
