MINUTES

COUNCIL

REGULAR MEETING JAN. 15, 1974

Those present: Fowler, Thompson, Hopkins, O'Dell and Mayor Holladay

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor, meeting with the council were Mr. Perry, & Lee Gamble with Nationwide Ins. Co. to present a bid to the Town Of Central for insurance to cover all the Town ownes. A proposal for the Town Hall, & Fire Dept. was presented at \$75,000. Also meeting with the council was Mr. Randy Strickland with Pilot Life Ins. Co. proposing for the municipality Group Hospital Ins. Policy, which covers \$40 a day room and board, \$800 Misc. (70 days coverage), \$30,000 Major Medical, restoration \$1,000 annually, \$100 cash deduction. Cost \$12.60 for a individual, \$34.59 for a family coverage per month.

After discussion on the bids for insurance of the Town of Central, a motion by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins, that the Finance Committee be in charge to decide on the insurance for the Town. Motion carried.

Mr. Holladay (Mayor) stated that the Sifford, Kimbrell, & Carson Apts. have been taken care of, and they would be in the office to pay soon. The information stated above relates to town taxes for 1973.

Council suggested that the Chief of Police go to the stores and see what type of machines are located in them, and who they belong to.

Motion by Thompson, 2nd by O'Dell to annex the 2nd Wesleyan parsonage into the city limits, and that they be given a free sewerage tap. Motion carried.

Discussion on the old backhoe was in question as whether to keep in possession or to sell, after discussion, motion by Fowler and ammended by O'Dell to get an estimate for the repairs on the backhoe and leave in the equipment lot on reserve in case the new on wasn't in operation.

The matter of the water problem at the underpass was brought before the council. Mayor Holladay asked Mr. Hopkins (St. Committee) to check into this matter.

Thompson stated that Mrs. Inez Herd had asked for a street light between her house and Mrs. Berry's, council overruled, as stated in the minutes that street lights be placed at the corners of Sts. only

Motion by O'Dell and 2nd by Hopkins that the meeting adjourn.
