

Regular Council Meeting, January 16, 1983

Present: Mayor Sumney, Mayor Pro-tem Chaka, Councilmen Dan Evatt, Doc Evatt, Troy Porter, Administrator Olin Gambrell, Clerk Grace Towe, Paul Davidson, Greenville News, Lisa Garrett, Messenger, Anderson Independent Representative; Councilman Carl Rampey was absent due to being called to work early.

Minutes of the December 12, 1983 minutes were read. Motion by Mr. Chaka, seconded by Mr. Dan Evatt to approve.

Petition from Mr. Jack Dunn to annex 4' strip of property. Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Porter to accept for further study. Vote was 3-1 (Dan Evatt opposed seeing no benefit to town.

Petition-Moratorium on building--Mr. Porter made the motion to accept for further study, Seconded by Mr. Chaka--Vote unanimous.

Chief Frank Cantrell presented the police report with summary and 2 year comparison. Mayor Sumney read a letter from Pratt Read Company commending the Fire Department for the quick response to the fire.

Doc Evatt--Recreation Church basketball has started.. Noted the underpass needs sandblasting and beautifying. Some street lights out.

Troy Porter---Student Condo Housing to be discussed later.

Frank Chaka--1½" water line on Gaines St. needs replacing--No pressure.

Administrator's Report:

Mr. Gambrell presented the financial report. Noted the last payment for 1983 was low.

Asked permission to bid out unused town equipment.

CWC check for \$200.00 had been issued for scoreboard.

Motion by Mr. Dan Evatt, second by Mr. Doc Evatt that expense vouchers for mileage be approved by entire council before payment--Vote unan.

Mr. Doc Evatt made the motion, seconded by Mr. Dan Evatt to collect 12 months figures on actual radio maintenance cost, versus contract cost for same period. Una Motion by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Doc Evatt to adjourn--Vote unan.
