A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, February 1, 1971 at 7:00 P. M. at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor, H. R. Holladay, Councilmen Herbert Thompson, Jr., Jack Kennemore, J. R. Herd, Glen D. O'Dell, A. B. Cumbie, Jr. and George Fowler. Also present for the meeting was Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Some discussion was held on changing the Town Council Meetings to a later date in the month. It was agreed that the Meeting night be changed from the first Monday to the third Tuesday of each month.

Some discussion was held on the per centage of sewerage surcharge that Cannon Mills should be required to pay. After discussion, Councilman Cumbie made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler that Cannon Mills be charged 15% of their Water Useage for their Sewerage Surcharge. This motion was unanimously carried.

Also the question of Central Concrete Company Sewerage Surcharge was discussed. Councilman Cumbie made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler that Central Concrete Company be charged 50% Sewerage Surcharge on their 1½ inch meter and no Sewerage Surcharge on their 2" meter. This motion was unanimously carried.

Some discussion was held on the use of Plastic bags for garbage collection, but no action taken on this matter.

A lengthy discussion was held on the Rural Fire Protection. After much discussion, Councilman O'Dell made a motion, seconded by Councilman Cumbie, that we charge \$12.00 per year for Fire Protection to rural residents effective as of March 15, 1971. Areas covered as follows: to the Daniel School Area-North, to Highway 88-South, to the Mt. Tabor Church or Clemson City Limits-West and to the Midway Community-East. It was also agreed that we continue to serve the rural areas as usual until March 15, 1971-as usual.

Some discussion was held on the purchasing of a battery charger for the Fire Dept. Councilman Cumbie made a motion to purchase this battery charger, cost to be approximately \$200.00, seconded by Councilman O'Dell. This motion was unanimously carried.

Police Chief, Harold Duncan was present and gave his Police report for the month of January, 1971. Chief Duncan also reported to the Council that the Town was required to send to the State Treasurer each month an assessment for each case or arrest made. Chief suggested that the fines be increased \$5.00 on all fines not exceeding \$100.00. After some discussion Councilman Kennemore made a motion, seconded by Councilman Fowler that all fines be increased as suggested by Chief Duncan. This vote was unanimous.


