The Town Council met February 3, 1966, with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilmen G.D. O'Dell, J.R. Herd, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin, Jerry Lesley, W.J. Wilson, ~~and~~ Mars. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper and Mr. Chizzle & Mr. Hun, who were interested in buying water from the Town of Central.

Mayor Kelley presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved, after which Mr. Chizzle was introduced to give his proposal of forming a water district on Maw Bridge, Madden Bridge and Pike Roads. Mr. Chizzle stated that he had approximately 22 people who ~~had~~ would be interested in connectioning on to the water if this district could be formed. Mr. Chizzle's proposal is as follows: That he install all water lines, make all water taps receiving taping fees and water deposits, which would go to him, and that the Town be responsible for ~~maintenace~~, maintenance of all lines, reading of meters, sending out statements of water readings and collecting same, at the rate of \$1.00 per meter per month which would go into a savings for the upkeep of lines, and pay five cents above cost of which the Town pays Easley-Central Water District. Councilman O'Dell made a motion that a contract be drawn up subject to the approval of the Council & Mayor. Councilman Wilson seconded the motion. The Council voted favorable of having this contract drawn up.

The Council agreed for the Town Clerk to write a letter to Mr. S.N. Pearman, of the State Hwy. Dept., asking for forms pertaining to delinquent tax, and that the Policeman contact delinquent tax payers again before having their names sent into the Hwy. Dept.

A discussion was held on selling gasoline to the Rescue Squad for their truck at the same price the Town is paying per gallon to Lake and Sam Williams Gulf Oil Distributors. Councilman Lesley made a motion that the Rescue Squad be allowed to buy gas from the Town. Councilman O'Dell seconded the motion. All Council members agreed.

Councilman O'Dell gave an estimate on Fire Ins. for the garbage truck and water truck from Dowling Ins. Agency. Councilman Martin made a motion that a \$100.00 deductable Fire Ins. Policy be purchased from Dowling Ins. Agency. Councilman Busha seconded the motion. All Councilman members agreed.

Councilmen also agreed on the following: to check prices on tool boxes for water truck-to either have decals put on water truck or water Dept. painted on truck, and to check further on prices of rain coats, boots & hats for Firemen.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
