A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, February 5, 1968, at 7:00 P.M. with the following attending: Mayor L.S. Griffin, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, W.W. Norwood, J.R. Herd, G.H. Werner, W.A. Parsons, and A.R. Cureton. Also present were Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger, and Mrs. Louise Bell, representing the Greenville News.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting, The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Garland Morrison from the Central Rescue Squad was present at the meeting, and he brought before the Council a request for written permission from the Mayor and Town Council to direct traffic at funerals, and etc. After some discussion on this matter, a motion was made by Councilman Bryan, seconded by Councilman Herd, that the Town ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ should consult our Town Attorney, John Gentry, about this request, and then work from there. All Council agreed.

It was reported to the Council that John Head had offered to pay \$100.00 for the pump, extension, Motor, ell and check-valve that had been used in the old Filter Plant . After some discussion on this, Councilman Werner made a motion to sell this to John Head for the said amount of \$100.00. Councilman Herd seconded the motion, all Council agreed.

There was futher talk of the Red Taylor Water-Line at the meeting. It was stated that the Council had made Mr. Taylor an offer, and it would be up to him to make a reply to the Town.

The problem of riding bicycles on the sidewalks was brought before the Meeting, and it was noted that there is an Ordinance against riding bicycles on the streets and sidewalks in town. It was suggested that the Chief of Police remind the bicycle-riders of this Ordinance, and try to ~~XXXXXXXX~~ curb this problem.

The Insurance on the Town Vehicles was another matter of discussion. Councilman Norwood made a motion that the Town renew the following policies for the year of 1968:
Policy No: GA 307 05 33 46 with Dowling Insurance Agency for \$231.00 &
Policy No: 61-FL-981-328 Fleet Policy with Nationwide Mutual Insurance Co. for \$652.75
Councilman Bryan seconded this motion and the motion was carried.

The question regarding the Clemson Newspaper write-up on the slum areas of Central was discussed at length, but no definite action was taken on this matter.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
