February 6, 1961

The Town Council held their regular meeting February 6, 1961, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carso, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, J.J. Canup, R.A. Bush, J.A. Cranford, W.J. Wilson, Roy E. Golden Supt. Water-works, Milton Moser Assist. Supt. and Chief Reams, also Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger Paper and Miss Summy representing the Monitor Paper.

Mayor Carson presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Golden and Mr. Moser gave a report on the water and a discussion was held on getting a larger pump for the filterplant. but no action was taken. Mr. Moser mentioned that he had not had a pay raise since he had been hired as Assistant Supt. for the water-works and thought he was due one. Mr. Busha made a motion that ~~MRXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Mr. Moser be given a 10% raise effective February 10, 1961. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council agreed. Mr. Golden said that he would like for someting to be worked out by spring in order for him to have one day a week off.

Mr. Carson said that he had talked with Mr. Dowling about keeping the Bank open one afternnon each week and that he would talk with officals of Pratt Read Co. and Cannon Mills to find out which day of the week would be preferred.

The Council also discussed the garbage pickup. But no action was taken on this.

It was mentioned that a number of people had requested a right ~~turn~~ on red at the traffic lgght, with caution. This did not meet the approval of the Councilmen since such a signal would endanger the lives of school children crossing the street.

A bell on the telephone in order for the police to hear the phone ring from any parts of town was discussed. The Council agreed for Mr. Reams to talk with the Telephone Co. about installing this.

Being no futher business the Council adjourned.
