The Town Council met Thursday night, February 6, 1964, 7:30 P.M. at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen, C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin, W.J. Wilson, Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper and Mr. Frank Catanzaro, agent for the Equity Life Annuity Ins. Co. were also present.

Mayor Cranford presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on moving the play ground equipment from the old school playground across the road to the present playground. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the town bear the expense of having the equipment moved and that John Head be ask to do this work. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Bryan made a motion that Mrs. Chapman be given a check for \$17.47 covering ~~the~~ one-third of gas bills which is the amount used by the Public Library for Oct., Nov. Dec. of 1963 and Jan. of 1964. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on the purchasing of more fire hose for the Fire Dept. Mr. Wilson made a motion that Mr. Bryan and Mr. Martin who are members of the Fire Dept. meet with the other members of the Dept. and find out if the hose should be purchased. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A discussion was held on having an ordinance drawn up by Attorney John Gentry for the purpose of having only one dwelling connected to each water meter. Mr. Busha made a motion that this Ordinance be drawn up. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion.

Plans for a Town Hall were mentioned. Mr. Cranford ask that a letter be written to Davidson, N.C., asking the Clerk to borrow their plans to be studied by the Town Council.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
