

Regular Council Meeting
February 8, 1988 7:00pm

Present: Mayor Alton Cumbie, Clarenece Phillips, Harry Holladay, "Doc" Evatt,
Frank Chaka, Henry Law, Troy Porter and Mandy Bobo, The Messenger.

Meeting was called to order by the Mayor.

Innvocation by Harry Holladay.

Reading of the Minutes of the Regular Council Meeting of January 11, 1988 and the
Special Called Meeting of January 28, 1988 by Mayor with motion for acceptance as
read by Mr. Chaka, second by Mr. Law. Vote Unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Law--Gave Police Report.

Mr. Chaka-- Gave Financial Report. Mayor had question on where to put a reimbursement
payment from the insurance company for the equipment that was stolen from the Town.
The money will be used to buy equipment to replace that which was stolen.

Decision to call Auditors for advise.

Also question on \$1369 spent on paint. Decision to see if the Town can be re-
imbursed for unused portion.

Mr. Porter--Not present at that time.

Mr. Phillips--NONE

Mr. Holladay-- went to meeting for Small Towns Program. Mayor went over the possible
options for the Town with the \$2500 marketing study. Discussion of what the program
would provide. Steering Committee consists of Harry Holladay, Theresa Cooper, Donna
Chuck Barnes and Shelley Roper. Mayor suggested that Mr. Boozer come before Council and Towns people with presentation. Steering Committee to come to next Work Session with findings on interested parties. *Barnes*

Mr. Evatt-- Mayor advised on progress of 4-Way Stop at Pepper and College Street.
Need to send letter requesting the 4-Way stop and State will put up signs. Letter
to be sent.

Discussion of letter sent to Roy Collins. Mr. Phillips had question on progress
of Folger street project. Advised that Cannon has not made any contact with the
Town.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Law--Rural Fire Update. Suppose to have meeting 2-8-88 but due to a fire the
Meeting was cancelled.

Mayor answered Mr. Holladay's question on the \$500 in insurance; is for fee for
the fire truck that has to respond to a fire. Fee does not pertain to us but the
\$500 is a clause and must be paid irregardless.

Mr. Chaka--requested that all Department heads begin to work on next years budget.

Mr. Porter--Discussion of draft of the Recreation Department Policy. Changes noted
and discussed. Mayor suggested a Public Work Session on the changes for the Policy.

Mr. Phillips--Update on East Clemson Water District. Nothing done at this time. The Mayor advised that they would be meeting with East Clemson.

Mr. Holladay--Mr. Porter had question on line repaired at Joseph and Brock street being a six inch line. Mayor to find out.

Mr. Evatt-- noted that alot of the pot holes in Town had been repaired. Discussion of signs and parking on Watkins street. Mayor talked with Chief Cantrell who feels that yellow lines for no parking would be sufficient with enforcement. Mr. Holladay also suggested that Joe's Income Tax Service may want to put One Hour parking signs at their place of business.

Brock street drainage being taken care of as advised by the Mayor.

Mr. Phillips noted that the large concrete pipes at the Old Jail are being played on by the neighborhood children which presents a dangerous situation. Needs to be looked into.

Mr. Porter mentioned that the trees and brush need to be cut back on Joesph street from Wood to Brock. Mr. Holladay mentioned that Eaton from Brock to Johnson Rd also needs cutting back.

Mayor's Report--Noted that Man Power study was under way. Noted letter from Judge Cranford, glad to see a stand being taken on issues.

Mayor appointed Mr. Evatt, Mr. Law and Mr. Chaka (chairman) to the Personnel committee for Christmas bonus pay.

Made Council aware that Central will be hosting the Municipal Association February 22, 1988.

With no Further Business, the meeting was adjourned.
