Feb. 10, 1975

Those Present: Councilmen Porter, Busha, Fowler, Thompson, Kennemore, & Hopkins, St. Supervisor John Head, Chief of Police Harold Duncan, Mayor Holladay, Park Director John Hunt, Town Attorney Mr. Acker, Jack Dunn, Howard Leonard, Engineer. News Media Jerry Alexander, (Anderson Independent)

Mayor called the meeting to order stated to the council the balance in various accounts for the Town of Central.

Meeting with the council were Mr. Jack Dunn, his engineer Howard Leonard. Leonard stated that seem their were some conflict of getting together on the matter of water being run to Mr. Jack Dunn's property. The mayor then referred back to the minutes on Oct. 13, 1974 where the council offered to furnish labor from the town, Dunn furnish pipe providing the line be deeded back to the town after installation. Mr. Dunn then requested that the town buy pipe and let him intall the line himself. After a lengthy discussion the council felt they should maintain the agreement made with Mr. Dunn on Oct. 13, 1974. Mr. Dunn asked for more time to think about this matter.

Meeting with the council was the Town Attorney Bill Acker to advise on the legal status concerning business license for operation inside the Town of Central. Acker stated that on a beer license where it was being solded^{and served} their should be a higher fee because of the involving of the police officers, a fee of not less than \$100.00. Will notify within the next 24 hours concerning liquor license.

Motion made Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins to table issue of license for Jim Swinford & Poll Knowland until futher study of what this situation consist of. Council voted unanimously.

The matter of business license for Mae's Beauty Shop was then brought before the council. After Mr. Acker looked at the zoning ordinance that was adopted Sept. 18, 1973 stated according to the ordinance that Mrs. McAlister was in error, R-12 zone states no business can be established, residential area only. Motion made by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins to uphold the zoning ordinance, that a letter be written to Mrs. McAlister giving her sixty (60) days to make other arrangements. Council voted unanmously.

Motion by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins for John Hunt to buy what ever needed to fix windows & a sink located at the Central Park. Town will reimburse John. Council approved.




