MINUTES REGULAR MEETING COUNCIL FEB. 14, 1977

Present: Bolt, Hopkins, Kennemore, Porter, Thompson, Holladay, Bethea, Jim Richards & Paul Wood from Harwood Bebee, Phyllis Boyles & George Reid.

Jim Richards made a presentation concerning the rainwater infiltration and possible opportunity for a grant to do an infiltration/Inflow Study. Motion by Thompson second by Hopkins that we make resolution to allow the Harwood Bebee Company make an application for grant money for the infiltration/inflow study and the council would make a decision on acceptance of grant match if awarded. Motion passed.

George Reid discussed possibility of getting water tap down the Maw Bridge Rd. He said he would see how many individuals he could get to sign up for taps and report back to another council meeting.

Chief reported that the part time man (Bill Wilhoit) was working out okay. Request was approved to pay Gilstrap \$26.40 for mileage to Columbia for photo that was necessary for certification of the Police Dept.

Bolt made a report from the police committee which was distributed at the last call council meeting on the change ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXX~~ that the trial date would be set on the 1st and 3rd Monday's at 3:00 P.M.

Council approved the okay for the process of renovation at the old school building. Porter stated that he would give the go ahead to the individual (Beautyguard Aluminum Siding Manufacturers) who contracted this job at \$4,483.00 for placing boxing & guttering. ~~guttering~~

Mayor recommended that Hal Garrett, E. L. Bolick and L.O. Evatt be nominated as members of the Central Planning Commission serving from March 20, 1977 to March 20, 1980. Motion by Thompson and second by Bolt that the council accept mayor's recommendation. Motion passed.

Bethea was informed that Adline Earle's request for water at Leonard Oates house would be met if Earle agreed to pay for cost of boring under highway, cost of pipe to the meter connect from 6' water main and the usual water tap on fee & meter deposit.

Bethea was authorized to purchase two more traps and a catch stick for the animal control officer.

Decided that town still haul gravel to individuals at the cost of gravel.

Motion by Thompson and second by Hopkins giving 1st reading approval to an ordinance creating an auxillary police force. Motion carried.
