MINUTES

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

FEB. 16, 1976

Those Present: Mayor Holladay, Councilmen: Porter, Thompson, Fowler, Kenemore, & Hopkins, Town Attorney Bill Acker, St. Superintendent John Head, Police Chief Harold Duncan, Jimmy Langston, Stanley Barrett, News Reporter Jerry Alexander (Anderson Independent), John Hunt, & Recorder Catherine Hughes.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting to order and ask John Head to give a brief report on the sewerage project that concerned the 201 Plan. John stated to the council that he had plugged approximately (10) holes, placed 6 new covers on manholes that were faulty, bush hogged approximately 10,000 ft. of right-a-ways. John stated that he felt that 50% of this extra water flow coming into our system has been taken care of. John ask the question about private property; approximately 3 or 4 individuals have holes in the sewer lines. Council have John the okay to contact each individual to repair these lines, if individual can't do thier own repairs the council gave permission to John to do repairs and bill the individual for time & materials though the office, this to be paid by the individual. Motion by Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins. Motion carried on the above repairs.

Motion by Hopkins, 2nd by Porter for John & Fowler to purchase whatever supplies are needed for this sewerage project (201) plan. Ten (10) manhole covers etc.

Motion by Porter, 2nd by Hopkins to accept recommendation for pump to be used at the North & South Treatment Plants. Approximately \$600.00. Council approved.

Jimmy Langston met with the Town Council concerning availability of water & sewer lines to the Sub-Division located on Pratt Read Rd. After Jones Engineers survey was made he learned that only 10 units could reach our exiting lines. A lift station will have to be placed. Langston's proposal to the Town of Central is to pay for water & sewer taps (\$10.00) for each tap, lots 1-13, buy the pump for the lift station with the Town's approval on the pump, for the Town to place (3) manholes, plus build (1) manhole for the pumping station, place 1 fire hydrant in development. Langston agreed's to bear expeince if the Town hits rock running the lines to lots 1-13, for the Town to surface & maintain St. to the development. Langston proposed that if lines to lots 1-13 were installed he would run the remaining lines of the other development himself. All St., lines, etc. will be dedeed back to the Town & Town will maintain same. The future development must mee all town requirements.
