A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, March 2, 1970, at 6:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor, L. S. Griffin, Councilmen, W. W. Norwood, George Fowler, J. R. Herd, Herbert Thompson, Jr. & A. R. Cureton. Also present was Mrs. Maude Chapman with the Messenger.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Police Chief, Wess Adams, gave his report from the period of February 1st. - 28th., 1970. During this time there were a total of 30 arrests made and \$550.00 collected.

The question of a night policeman was brought before the Council, and present for an interview was John Manley from Pendleton. The Town Council interviewed Mr. Manley, but no disposition was made.

The question of purchasing two lawn mowers for the Mt. Zion Cemetery was brought before the Council, and Councilman Thompson made a motion to purchase two lawn mowers, provided we get three bids first. This expense was to come out of the Cemetery Funds.

The question of having Ordinances passed concerning parking on Main Street and etc. was discussed. It was decided to make a survey of the different streets and etc. over the Town, and then decide which signs would go where and which signs that would need to be ordered.

A letter from Mr. Chisman pertaining to the Water Works was turned over to the Water Works Committee to handle.

The problem of old junked cars and nuisances about and over the Town, was discussed. An Ordinance prepared by Mr. John Gentry, Town Attorney, was read by Mayor Griffin relating to the Abatement of Nuisances. Councilman Fowler made a motion, seconded by Councilman Cureton to accept the Ordinance as read. This ~~Motion~~ was unanimously carried.

The question of a 6" Water Line on the S. C. Carson property was discussed at length. After discussion, Councilman Thompson made a motion seconded by Councilman Herd, to run a 6" water line along with a fire hydrant to the property of Mr. S. C. Carson, the water line running from the fire hydrant on the other side of the underpass to the Carson property corner, being approximately 200 feet. This vote was unanimously carried.

Councilman Fowler made a motion, seconded by Councilman Norwood to take bids on the old Police car, bids to be opened at the April Council Meeting. This vote was unanimously carried. This was to be less the light and siren on the old police car.

Mr. J. Allen Thompson, Jr. with the S. C. Regional Housing Project Authority was present at the meeting, and explained how we could
