MINUTES ***** South Carolina

At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council held on Monday night March 3, 1952 at 7:00 P. M. the following were present: Honorable G. M. Perry, Mayor; W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police; Councilmembers, S. C. Carson, Frank Abercrombia, C. F. James and Calvin Rampey.

The meeting was called to order and the first thing to be discussed was the Water Works System. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~
~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Mr. Perry told the councilmembers that Sirrine engineers had been called over and they have made various tests and come up with the idea of driving steel pile across the creek. They will drive it about 16 feet. Mr. Perry also showed blueprints of the dam that Sirrine engineers had drawn up. Several contractors were called and they let bids. One was \$10,300, \$9,597 and Sloan Construction Co. bid at \$6,572.00. So the contract was let to Sloan. The town will also have to buy land at the creek, they have in mind about 20 acres and also a V that belongs to Leroy Chamberlain. The PWA agreement won't let the Commission float bonds to pay for all this so the Town will buy this material and the Commission will pay us back. A round table discussion was carried on about the above and after this S. C. Carson made a motion that the Town borrow the money but first contact at least three (3) agencies to see about the rate of interest and get it down in writing. Frank Abercrombie 2nd the proposal of S. C. Carson. Mr. Perry said he had contacted one person and could get the money at 4%. He and the finance committee are to look into this and borrow the money at the lowest rate of interest. It was agreed upon by all.

S. C. Carson made a motion that Mrs. James see and get prices on a used or new typewriter. Frank Abercrombie 2nd the above. The council members were in favor of this.

Mr. Gaines reported that the safety director of the State Highway had called upon the school and they are trying to work out something safe and satisfactory.

The meeting then adjourned.
