March 3, 1969

A regular meeting of the Town Council was held on Monday, March 3, 1969 at 7:00 P. M. with the following attending: Mayor L. S. Griffin, Councilmen George Fowler, Herbert Thompson, Jr., J. R. Herd, W. W. Norwood, and C. B. Bryan.

Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

The plans for the new Town Hall were discussed. The question pertaining to the doors was discussed. After much discussion, Councilman Fowler made a motion, seconded by Councilman Norwood, that there be a door going from the assembly room (middle wall) into the fire station, and also an outside door on Werner Street going into the assembly room. All Council Members agreed.


The question regarding the Garbage Dump and the amount being charged to the Town of Central by the Town of Clemson was discussed at length. Councilman Thompson made a motion, seconded by Councilman Bryan that we pay the Town of Clemson \$180.00, which represented September, October, and November, 1968. Other action taken pertaining to this Garbage Dump, was that the Mayor check with Mr. Carlisle Durham to determine what we might expect from the County.

The question regarding the Police car was discussed, but no action was taken on this matter.

There was some discussion on the operation of pin-ball machines within the City Limits of Central. After some discussion on this matter a motion was made by Councilman Fowler, seconded by Councilman Herd, that the law be enforced on the pin-ball machines, as quoted in the Ordinance of 1960. This vote was carried unanimously.

There was no further business transacted at this meeting.
