The Town Council met Thursday night, February 4, 1965, at 7:30 P.M., with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilmen Glenn D. O'Dell, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin, J.R. Herd, J.B. Lesley,

Mayor Kelley presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A lengthy discussion was held on the future planning for improvements of the sewage system. The Council agreed that Engineers should be contacted to give an estimate of cost on needed improvements. Councilman O'Dell stated that he would contact the Engineering Dept. of Clemson College and make an appointment to have someone from the Dept. to discuss this matter with the Council.

The Council agreed for the Mayor and Town Clerk to sign agreements to property deed to William B. Ducker, property for new Post Office building.

Mayor Kelley, Councilmen Martin, Herd and Busha, reported they had checked the distance from Councilman O'Dell's house to the nearest Fire Hydrant. The Council agreed that a hydrant should be placed near O'Dell's home to serve the people in that area. Councilmen Herd and O'Dell were appointed to check on the location for the hydrant.

Mayor Kelley stated that he would talk with Mr. W.A. Gaines about a place to shelter town equipment.
