At the meeting of the Town Council held on March 5, 1951 at 7:00 P. M. the following were present: G. M. Perry, Mayor; Frank Abercrombie, C. F. James, Calvin Rampey, J. W. Wallace, Jr. and S. C. Carson.


The meeting was called to order. Mr. Perry ask if there were any reports from the various committee. The sewer committee then discussed Mr. Owens sewer line and the council felt that offering to go 100 ft was all that they could do. The Council decided to get a list of all the outside ~~XXXX~~ toilets before deciding anything definite on this. J. W. Wallace made a motion that W. A. Gaines, Police check the town and make out a list of all outside toilets still in use. When this list is made up call a meeting of the Council. The Council then decided to have this meeting March 12, 1951 at 7:00 P. M. or at a later date if this date if found impracticable. Mr. Gaines will take the resolution which was made for March 1, 1951 as deadline for outside toilets and warn each house about this.

Calvin Rampey then brought up the traffic. He said that main St. was like a race tract and wanted to know about getting a caution light for each end of town. Mr. Perry has tried to get a caution light from the highway for ages but hasn't been able to get one. The highway has to give a right of way for anything that is put upon the state highway and Mr. Perry said that he would rather they would put up the light and maintain it.

A raise for Sara James, Town clerk & Treas. was discussed. S. C. Carson made motion ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ that the Clerk & Treas. Mrs. Sara James, be paid \$40.00 per week, effective as of March 1. This motion was 2nd by Calvin Rampey and was unanimously carried.

The meeting was then adjourned.
