The Town Council met Thursday night, March 5, 1964, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, G.L. Martin. J. Marion Campbell, Town Auditor and Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper were also present.

Mayor Cranford presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Campbell, Town Auditor was present to explain the audit which consist of the years of 1961, 1962 and 1963. The Town Council agreed to let Mr. Campbell do the audit for 1964.

Extension of water lines to Prasley Acres and families on Sheriff Road and Rollinsville were discussed. Mr. Cranford stated that an inspector from the State Board of Health had advised that an analysis be made of the water before supplying any customer in this area. The Council agreed that Mr. Golden should have this done.

The Fire Dept. was discussed. Mr. Martin said that the Department was not in need of any more hose at the present time. The Council agreed not to purchase any more hose at this time if not needed.

A discussion on having merchants to build garbage bins behind the buildings in order to keep garbage from being scattered. Mr. Cranford said that he would contact the merchants.


Since no futher information has been received on a new Post Office for the Town of Central it was decided to write to Congressman Dorn concerning this matter.
