MINUTES REGULAR MEETING (COUNCIL) MARCH 9, 1976

Those Present: Mayor Holladay, Councilmen: Fowler Hopkins, Porter, Kennemore, Thompson, Chief of Police Harold Duncan, John Bethea Town Administrator.

Minutes of the last called meeting wasn't read or approved. (They are ready)

2: \$50,000.00 has been transferred to Town of Central Savings account to compound 5% daily.

3. Sewer leaks at Owens and Barron apts. each owner has been notified. They said that they would take care of their problem.

4. EPA says phosphorus will have to be removed from our waste water in the next 5 years.

5: Help for John Head, (Millard Dawson) said he would have to take home \$125.00 after deductions. Porter made motion if Dawson suite John approval to offer him \$135.00 per week and he would have to go to school, 2nd by Fowler. Motion carried.

6. John Bethea gave the report of LEAP Grant, also a grant for Highway Safety Signs.

7. Melvin Brooks water lines that were taped illegal was in discussion. Suggestion was made that we find our ordinance and show him before action was taken.

8. Sewerage at La Vista Apts. the owner came by and talked to Mr. Holladay. The Owner said he would talk to his lawyer about this matter. The owner stated it should be the contractors responsibility to pay this fee.

9. Mayor Holladay read a letter from Mr. Garrett concerning rent of the Old Carolina National Bank. The banks offer was \$200.00 a month rent with option to buy within the next 12 months. The sale price of the bank is \$25,000.00. This was read as information.

10. St. signs 4-25mph signs, 2-30mph (min. parking signs) 1-15min. parking. Porter wanted to know why these signs hasn't been bought..

11. Help for the office was discussed Herbert & John to talk with Catherine agreement to be made on Mon. night.

12. Porter brought up the concession stand at the ball park as to let Mr. E.B. Thomas operate it on profit bases of 50%. The council approved his request to operate the concession stand. He will have to buy half of the business licens.
