

Regular Council Meeting
March 9, 1987

Present: Mayor Alton Cumbie; Harry Holladay, Frank Chaka, Troy Porter, ("Doc" Eavtt away on business trip);(Clarence Phillips out with surgery) Henry Law ; Olin Gambrell, Mr. & Mrs. David Boyles, Mike Stockwell, Terry Creager of the Greenville News.

Mayor Cumbie called the meeting to order.

Invocation by Mr. Holladay. Minutes of the February 9, 1987 meeting were read.

Motion by Henry Law, second by Frank Chaka to accept as read. Vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Law---Discussed hiring of Matt Culbreath as police officer. Welcomed Matt to the staff.

Mr. Holladay noted that police officers need to walk more.

Mr. Law gave the police report---discussion of the proposed budget for the Fire Department and prospect of new dump tank.

Mr. Chaka--Gave the financial report with notation of the excessive workmen's compensation.

Mr. Porter--Recreational Report--No report on rests. Mr. Gambrell notes an estimate of \$2200 to \$2500 for repairs. Discussion of doors versus gates. Recommendation by Mr. Porter for solid wood doors to be locked except for when designated activity going on. Mayor Cumbie accepted Mr. Porters recommendation and noted more police protection needed for area.

Mr. Porter requested itemized break-down of estimation. Mayor made motion for Mr. Porter and Mr. Gambrell, knowing the boundaries to take action on restrooms, and get ready for use. This seconded by Mr. Chaka. Vote unanimous.

Basketball additions: Mr. Gambrell had estimates on 4 backboards of \$2,065.35. Recommendation by Mr. Gambrell to go with Harris Sporting Goods. Mayor Cumbie asked for motion on this, Motion by Mr. Porter, second by Mr. Law, vote unanimous.

Baseball-Softball update: Had meeting on 3-9-87 Schedule 9,10,11 tournament April and end first half of season.

Trophies to go to 1st and 2nd place in tournament. Baseball signup for February 15, Practice March 14, at 10:00 am.

Discussion of Basketball Camp--Discusses liability to town

Mr. Holladay noted bleachers behind homeplate need repairs. Mayor questioned tearing down old bleachers by first session in April. Motion by Mr. Porter, second by Mr. Law to level former bleachers and get two sections of aluminum ones. Vote unanimous.

Motion by Mayor Cumbie, second by Mr. Law to clear up problem behind Little League. Mr. Gambrell requested help from Mr. Porter on above matters. Vote unanimous.

Mr. Phillips--out sick

Mr. Holladay---Noted the lot on Wood Street looks bad. Mayor asked Mr. Gambrell to contact owner of lot and make know council's concerns.

Mr. Evatt--away on business

NEW BUSINESS:

Mr. Stockwell recognized to explain water situation at house being rebuilt on Pepper St. Mr. Porter questioned why meter had not been pulled.

Mayor Cumbie wants Public Works supervisor to find out if water can be gotten from meter and where it goes, this to be done as soon as possible

Mr. Law---Recommended pursuit of fire district outside city limits. To ask for referendum. Discussion followed. Motion by Mr. Holladay, second by Mr. Law to proceed with County Council for procedures to establish fire district. Vote unam. Mr. Law to discuss with Mr. Bob Nash information on fire district. Mayor entertained motion to table motion until next session. Second by Mr. Porter, vote unanimous.

Mr. Chaka--Not report.

Mr. Porter--Recreation. Mr. Gambrell proposed a fence along Cannon Memorial Church property. \$475.00 to install. Discussion ensued.

Mayor designated Mr. Law, Evatt, Porter and Gambrell to discuss with people what they want and bring to council on road.

On diagram (attached) Mayor on #3 does not need first base fence.

Council voted to install the following:

1- 5 ft. fence at softball fence, down both first and third base line. Try and get Mr. Dyar to do something with dug out.

2- Put 4 ft. fence at little league field down 3rd base line only.

Mr. Phillips--none

Mr. Holladay--Need to research and bring back to next work session a proposed ordinance on swimming pool fence.

Mr. Porter--Status on Mt. Zion Cemetery. Administrator to contact attorney and send report to council.

Mayor's report:

Mayor briefed council on status of proposed road to White Oak apartment.

Site visit by C. O. G. update as to status of C.D.B.G.

Proposed Hwy 93 sewer line. Update on proposed sewer line to annex Hardees.


Highway 88 Water Line: Meeting with Easley-Central and Highway 88 to discuss proposed extension fo 10" water line.
