CENTRAL, S. C.
March 6, 1961

The Town Council held their regular meeting Monday Night March 6, 1961, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, J.A. Cranford, R.A. Busha, J.J. Canup, W.J. Wilson, H.M. Brooks, Waterworks Supt. Roy Golden Assist Supt. Milton Moser, Chief Reams Mr. Shoulbred with Harward Bee Bee Co. and a representative from Peerless Pumps was also present.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved after which Chief Reams gave a report on the cost of a telephone to be installed for the convenience of the police. He also said that he had talked with Southern Bell about a weatherproof box for the phone and he thought that it would be much cheaper to have a box made than to pay \$200 each month to Southern Bell for one. Mr. Wilson made a motion that Chief Reams see about having a metal weatherproof box made and the phone be installed. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Shoulbred with Harward Bee Bee Co. talked with the Councilmen and waterworks personnel about the amount of water needed to be pumped daily. Mr. Shoulbred suggested that the pipes be cut in several different places and checked to see if they were corroated or if there might be air in the pipes. He also suggested that the air valves on the lines should be opened up again. He stated that if the air valves were not in working condition that this might decrease the amount of water being pumped daily. He suggested that new valves be bought and installed. Mr. Busha made a motion that the valves be ordered and installed. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The council agreed.

A representative from Peerless Pump Co. was present to discuss the matter of a new pump for the Filterplant and the repair of the old pumps. He ~~suggested~~ suggested that the air valves be installed first and then let someone from Harward Bee Bee check the water capacity. He also added that it would be wise to have a representative from Peerless Pump Co. to be present when the lines are to be checked. Mr. Brooks made a motion that Harward Bee Bee be authorized to check the pipes. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The council agreed.

A discussion was held on the Firetruck being called out of the city limits. Mr. Cranford made a motion that a fee of \$25.00 be charged for this service. Mr. Brooks seconded the motion.

A discussion was held on the garbage pick-up. No action was taken.

Mayor Carson added that he wanted more thought put to the Clean -up Paint-up Fix-up month this year.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
