April 1, 1965

The Town Council and Mayor met Thursday night, April 1, 1965, 7:30 P.M., at the Town Hall with the following attending: Mayor Wayne C. Kelley, Councilman R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, J.R. Herd, J.L. Martin, Glenn D. O'Dell and Jerry Lesley. Mr. Shoulbred, a representative of Harwood BeeBee Co., was also present.

Mayor Kelley presided, the minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. Shoulbred, talked with the Council and Mayor and gave some advantages of the new type lagoons for the town sewer system. The Town Council agreed to have Mr. Shoulbred to make a proposal and present it to the Mayor and Council within the next two weeks at a special meeting to be held on Monday night, April 19, 1965.

A discussion was held on painting and doing some repair on the Town Hall. Mr. Lesley made a motion that an estimate be made on painting and some repair on the Hall. Councilman O'Dell seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

The Council discussed the most suitable location for the installation of a Fire hydrant, also the cost of pipe which will be needed. Mr. O'Dell and Herd were appointed to check on these.

The Council agreed to sell the right of way from the Filterplant to the creek to Duke Power, which is a 2400 volt transmission line owned by the Town of Central, with an easement along said right-of-way for the construction, operation and maintenance of a water line along and within the rights-of-way.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
