MINUTES - - - - -

At the meeting of the Town Council held on Monday April 2, 1951 at 7:00 P. M. the following were present: G. M. Perry, Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police, Frank Abercrombie, C. E. James, Calvin Rampey, J. W. Wallace, Jr. and S. C. Carson.

Mr. Arthur S. Hall, Engineer for Barnard and Burk, Consulting Engineers out of Baton Rouge, La. meet with the council and discussed the possibility of natural gas in this community. He has already visited with council members in Liberty, Clemson Pendleton and Easley and they let him investigate to see if there will be enough customers to put in the natural gas. The survey of Greenwood has been completed and they will float bonds to put in the gas lines.

C. F. James made a motion that we let them survey for the gas and after this if we want to float bonds we can and if we decide that we do not want the natural gas we do not have to have it put in. Barnard and burk do this survey for the sum of 1.00(one dollar). S. C. Carson 2nd this motion and the mayor is to sign agreement for the gas survey.

the Taxie business was discussed and the council agreed to give a license for a taxix in Central if he gets his ICC tag.

After the above the council adjourned.
