MINUTES

At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council held Monday April 2, 1956 at 7 P. M. the following were present: S. C. Carson, Mayor; Council members Doyle Elrod, C. B. Bryan, G. T. Newton and Grady Berry.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Carson and the minutes of the last meeting were read. There were no additions or changes and C. B. Bryan made a motion that the minutes be adopted Doyle Elrod 2nd this motion and the council voted unanimously.

A round table discussion followed concerning requirements for membership of our fire department in the S. C. State Firemen's Association. To participate in this a board of trustees of the Firemen's Insurance and Inspection Fund was set up. These trustees are Mayor Carson, C. B. Bryan, chairman of the fire committee, and Johnny Harper, Fire Chief.

Ordinances resisting arrest and interfering with the duties of the arresting officer were brought before the Council. C. B. Bryan made a motion that we adopt these two ordinances and G. T. Newton made the 2nd. The council voted unanimously.

Literature on mowers was passed around to the Council This bussiness was continued until the next meeting. Mrs. James will write for a demonstration man to come by and see the Mayor.

Mr. Carson reported to the Council that the sidewalks will be fixed in several weeks.

A discussion on our street markers followed. The ones that have been marked look good. Mr. Mauldin is doing the painting and the cost is \$1.50 an hour. He worked 8 hrs. painting the posts. Lettering of houses was discussed but nothing definite was worked out on this.

The meeting then adjourned.
