

# Town of Central

CENTRAL, S. C.

The Town Council met Thursday, April 5, 1962, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, W.J. Wilson, J.A. Cranford, R.A. Busha, J.J. Canup, H.M. Brooks. Representatives from the Greenville News and Messenger Papers and Mr. J.L. Brock were also present.

Mayor Carson presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on buying raincoats, hats and boots for the Fire Dept.. Mr. Brooks made a motion that \$200.00 be set aside for this purpose and let the Firemen decide how many and what style they would like to have. Mr. Canup seconded the motion. The Council agreed. Mr. Bryan was appointed to check with the Firemen and find out what type of suits they would like.

Extending the water and sewer lines in Kel-Car Acres was discussed. Mr. Carson said that he and Mr. Kelley would like to exchange the 700ft. of water line which they had installed in Kel-Car Acres to the Town for 750ft. of sewage line to be installed by the expense of the Town. This line to be run from the disposal plant to present Kel-Car Acres and at completion of said work the Town would be deeded for all streets, water lines and sewer lines presently in sub-division. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the Town extend the water lines as needed in any sub-division and the developer bear the expense of the sewer mains. Mr. Brooks seconded the motion.

A member of the newly organized Junior Chamber of Commerce called during the meeting and ask if they could be given permission to pick up all garbage cans on the streets and paint them as their first project. Mr. Busha made a motion that they be given permission to go ahead with this. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Wilson made a motion that Mayor Carson be given \$75.00 to help pay his expense to the Municipal Association meeting to be held at Myrtle Beach in May 1962. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.


Discussions were held on loud speakers and spitting on the streets. Mr. Brooks made a motion that an ordinance be drawn up against spitting on streets and that a \$5.00 fine be charged to anyone disobeying this ordinance, and that an ordinance be drawn up against loud speakers. Mr. Canup seconded the motion. Mr. Carson said that he would talk with John Gentry, Town Attorney, and have these ordinances drawn up.


Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
