MINUTES

At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council held Monday April 8 at 7 P. M. the following were present: S. C. Carson, Mayor; Councilmen F. E. Young, J. J. Canup, J. G. Center, C. B. Bryan and J. Cleo Bolding.

The meeting was called to order and the minutes of the March meeting were read. C. B. Bryan made a motion that the minutes be adopted. J. G. Center 2nd this motion and the Council voted unanimously.

Financial statements for March, 1957 were given to each member along with their check for the quarter. Financial statements of the Commission of Public Works were also distributed. Copies of each are attached to the minutes.

A round table discussion of the septic tank at Woodson's was carried on. After letter from Harwood Beebe was passed for the council to see and prices of installation were given, C. B. Bryan made a motion that we go ahead and apply for Federal Aid and after studying this if we decide that we can put this in cheaper ourselves than by contract, we will drop our proceedings for Federal Aid. J. G. Center 2nd this motion and the council were in agreement.

A resolution was adopted and signed by the Council for social security for our police and will be retractive to January 1956.

A general discussion followed on our telephone service. A letter from the Chamber of Commerce, Clemson, S. C. endorsing Southern Bell was read and the Council were reminded that the hearing on a petition by Central Telephone to sell to Home Telephone will be held at the Public Service Commission's office in Columbia at 11 A. M. April 23.

An invitation from Mayor W. C. Johnston to attend a luncheon at the Clemson House at 1 P. M. April 17 was read. This luncheon will be held to discuss issuing an invitation to the Municipal Association to hold its next meeting at the Clemson House. The meeting for 1957 is at Myrtle Beach May 5-7.

The Pickens County Municipal meeting was to be held in Central the 3rd Monday in April but this meeting has been postponed until May.

Finance Officer's training School will be held at the University of S. C. April 10-11. F. E. Young made a motion that Mrs. James attend this meeting and her expenses paid. J. J. Canup 2nd this motion and the Council voted unanimously.

Mr. Bolding reported that the Clean-Up week sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce will need some extra help. The Mayor said the Town would help by doing what work we could. Mr. Bolding also reported that the Cemetery looks good but he is not quite satisfied with it.

The Mayor reported that he had not heard from the Railroad on fixing the bank across from Main Street but he was sure they would do this.

A round table discussion on the Housing project followed. Nothing has been worked out on our sewer and water lines and as soon as we get plans, these lines will be installed.
