

Minutes  
Regular Council Meeting  
April 13, 1987

Present: Mayor Cumbie, Olin Gambrell, Clarence Phillips, Harry Holladay, "Doc" Evatt, Troy Porter, Frank Chaka (Henry Law at work), Terry Cregar Lori Warnock, and Wade Bryson.

Mayor called meeting to order.  
Invocation by Mr. Evatt.

Minutes of the March 9, 1987 meeting were read. Correction to Recreation Old Business to read use existing bleachers and look at probability of buying new ones next year. Addition to Recreation Old Business to read behind Little League Ball Field.

After corrections and addition motion by Mr. Chaka second by Mr. Porter to accept the minutes vote unanimous.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mr. Law--- at work. Mr. Holladay requested that Gambrell check on warnings for bicycle riding on the side walk.

Mr. Chaka----gave Financial Report. Question on payment of copier through the Equipment fund rather than the Reserve Fund. Gambrell to make correction. Mr. Holladay questioned elimination of Flower Fund. Mayor had question on building liability insurance. Gambrell to check on increase.

Mr. Porter---None. Gambrell gave update on work completed on restrooms.

Mr. Phillips---- None. Gambrell noted that they are progressing on the water extension on Highway 93. And that bids have been let out in reference to Hardee's.

Mr. Holladay--- Noted that letter had been sent to Mr. Coker on April 10 and he is to contact Mr. Gambrell by the 1st of May. Recommendation from Council to hire contractor to clean up and send him (Mr. Coker) the bill.  
Holladay also questioned swimming pool ordinance with Gambrell stating that more research needs to be done. Mayor decided to wait till next work session.

Mr. Evatt---Mr. Evatt and Mr. Porter met with a representative from Cannon Church in reference to the relocation of the street. Cannon is willing to give a 50ft. 40ft right-of-way with a 10ft. easement. This will follow the property line. Mayor questioned on whose expense this would be at. After discussion decision to wait until next work session.

FIRST READING OF ORDINANCES: Amendment to Section 3-211C and Addition of 3-216 and 3-217. Motion made by Chaka, second by Holladay. Vote Unanimous.

NEW BUSINESS:

Police--Mr. Law absent  
GAMBRELL gave a list of items that are up for bid by the Police Dept. Items will be run in the Messenger for a couple of weeks with the auction on 5-8-87.

Fire-----None.

Mr. Chaka requested everyone look at budget and try to come up with ways to cut. Mr. Chaka and Mr. Gambrell are to be getting with the dept. heads for justification of budget requests.

Mr. Porter--- Booster Club Agreement. Mayor read revised agreement. Motion for acceptance of changes by Mr. Porter, second by Mr. Phillips. Vote Unanimous. Mr. Bryson requested another week for Booster Club to pay Town and advised of possible purchasing of a portable concession stand. Mr. Porter recommended for better record upkeep that the Town receive a check from the Booster Club for the 30% agreed upon in last years agreement and that the Booster Club present a bill to the Town for captial improvements at which time the Town will pay the Booster Club up to \$750.00. Motion by Mr. Porter, second Mr. Phillips. Vote Unanimous.

Mr. Phillips--- None. Only requested that in budget cuts the water and sewer not be touched.

Mr. Holladay---Mayor on Hardee's construction, to begin May 1 with completion 2 months and 3 days later. Mr. Holladay had question on state and local policy on residents of Central who have license tags from out of state and to whom they pay taxes to. Mayor advised Mr. Gambrell to find out what could be done about this problem and if a list could be obtained of the residents of Central and who had out of state tags.

Mr. Evatt-- Mayor with figures on Duke Power for relighting and lighting up parts of Central area \$3,361.50. Mr. Holladay suggested before a decision was made it is best to complete the budget first.

#### MAYOR'S REPORT:

Utility Association of Pickens County resolution read. Evatt motioned to delay joining until liablility wording is better understood.

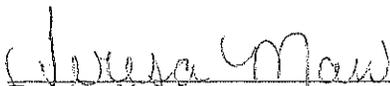
Mayor advised of Chamber of Commerce setting aside April 12-18 as clean up week for the Town of Central.
