

Regular Council Meeting  
April 14, 1980  
Minutes

Those present: Councilmen Hopkins, Thompson, Boyles, Chaka, Admin. Barney D. Jones, Clerk & Treas. Catherine Hughes, Chief of Police Frank Cantrell, representative from the news media Pickens Sentinel & Messenger.

Mayor Holladay called the meeting of April 10, 1980 to order and minutes of the last council meeting were read and approved as read.

Financial report for the month of March 1980 was presented to council and noted a change in intergovernmental grand totals to read \$34,935.

Chief Cantrell presented the police report for the month of March to council. Cantrell was asked by Council the status on auxiliary force. Chief stated he was looking into this matter. See report Attached.

Motion by Chaka seconded by Hopkins to adopt 2nd reading of Ordinance of Vehicles Parked in Residential District. Council passed without opposition.

Motion was made by Hopkins seconded by Thompson to accept 1st reading on a petition for annexation of property owned by Evans Bice College St. Gene Hedden (owned by Sybil D. Hedden), James Wilson, Second Wesleyan Church into town limits. Council passed without opposition.

Motion made by Hopkins seconded by Chaka to adopt 1st reading of an Ordinance annexation of said property above. Council passed without opposition.

Letter was read from auditor concerning the audit of the Police Dept. made after the resignation of Chief Besser. Audit report stated everything was clear.

Discussion was made on the Policy on the use of Town Hall Complex. Council stated that change be made relative to the storing of equipment in the bathroom to leave as is until other storage space is available and present at next regular Council Meeting for adoption.

Motion was made by Hopkins to adopt 1st reading of amended Budget Ordinance concerning (WATER & SEWER RATES). Motion did not carry due to the lack of a second therefore was tabled.

Motion was made by Thompson 2nd by Chaka to purchase fencing for little league ball field from lowest bidder with best quality. Council approved without opposition. This was AAA Fence Builders at cost of \$1040.00.

Purchase of Leaf Machine was tabled until next regular council meeting.




