Subject: Minutes of Town Council Meeting
April 17, 1973

Matters of Discussion:

1. Jim Gaines - Handicapped Children

Durham Development Center on Central Wesleyan College Campus. Title 4-A Money (Federal) Had to be certified Family income determined certification. Get \$8.29 per child. President Nixon has restricted certification and when it goes into effect there will be only one child certified. Give relief from 24 hour care to children by parents, this releases parents to go to work.

An income of \$280 per month rules out certification and the parent must pay \$15 per week for the child.

Support requested as follows:

County Council \$1800 which is 50%
Easley contributes \$9000 which is 25%
Central contributes \$1800 which is 5%

No Motion on this item - for consideration only.


X 4. J. C. Hunter property joining Harold Mann property - requests annexation. Request made from Mrs. T. N. Woody, Sr. of Madden Bridge Road. Motion made by Mr. Cumbie to investigate cost of providing service before taking action. Motion seconded by Dr. O'Dell.

5. Motion made by Mr. Fowler to employ commercial outfit to pump out Emloff tanks. Seconded by Mr. Hopkins. Council approved John Head to handle this.

6. Motion made by Mr. Thompson that the Street Committee purchase three (3) new lawnmowers. Seconded by Mr. Hopkins.

7. Mr. Fowler made the motion that the Town hire Mr. Bobby Busha to temporarily take over the entire operation of the Central Recreation organization at a weekly salary of \$75.00 per week. Seconded by Mr. Hopkins.
8. Motion made by Mayor Holladay to appoint Council members to work with Mr. Busha. Seconded by Mr. Fowler .
9. Motion made to make payment to Beeson. Seconded by Mr. Fowler.
10. Revised sick leave policy passed and ready for distribution.
