The Town council met Monday night, April 3, 1961 with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen J.A. Cranford, C.B. Bryan, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha and Mrs. Madude Chapman with the Messenger Paper, J.D. Horton.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on the waterworks. Mr. Carson said that he along with Mr. Busha and Mr. Cranford would check the air valves that were recently installed to see if they were properly installed.

Mr. Busha made a motion that the money received for firefighting be turned over to the Fire Dept. Mr. Wilson seconded the motion. The council agreed.

A discussion was held on giving J.D. Horton the authority to put a sand pump on the Town property approximately 50 ft. above the dam on 18 mile creek. Mr. Bryan made the motion that Mr. Carson and J.D. see John Gentry and draw up an agreement that Mr. Horton be given the right of way. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The council agreed.

The garbage pick-up was discussed. It was decided that it remain in the same hands until the remaining part of the six months is up. Mr. Carson said that he would talk to Mr. Bill McClallan from Clemson and get a definite proposal, also talk with Dr. Burns about the proposal the College made.


Mr. Wilson made a motion that a no U turn sign be put up between the Central Finance Co. and Martin's Esso Station. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion.
