Mayor Griffin presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and also two Special Call Meetings.

Police Chief, A. C. Arnold was present and made his report and brought before the Council the question of the \$3.00 fine that had previously been adopted for illegal parking. After discussing this question, there was no change recommended by the Council. There was a general discussion on drag racing and speeding and the traffic in general within the City Limits.
