May 6, 1965

The Town Council met May 6, 1965, with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilman R.A. Busha, Glenn D. O'Dell, J.L. Martin, J.R. Herd, W.J. Wilson.

Mayor Kelley, presided, The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

A discussion was held on the possibility of sending two volunteer Firemen to the State Firemen's Convention, which is to be held June 6th through the 8th at Myrtle Beach with expenses paid by the Town. Councilman O'Dell made a motion that two of the Firemen be sent to the convention with all expenses paid plus \$15.00 each for spending money. Councilman Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mayor Kelley, stated that Mr. W.A. Campbell had approached him about the possibilities of water and sewerage for a trailer court which ~~it~~ plans for the near future on the corner of Watkins & Werner Street. Councilman Martin made a motion that Mr. Campbell be not required to have a meter for each trailer parked on this lot, and that one commercial meter at the price of \$100.00, be installed to furnish water for the trailer park. Councilman Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

A further discussion was held on the fire hydrant which is needed on Eaton Street. Councilman Herd, stated that the distance from the hydrant nearest Mr. O'Dell's house was 1,500 ft.. The Council decided to meet on Tuesday night, May 11th. and make a decision on the most suitable location for this hydrant.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
