MINUTES - - - - - South Carolina

At the meeting of the Town Council held on Monday May 7, 1951 at 7:00 P. M. the following were present: G. M. Perry, Mayor W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police; J. W. Wallace, Jr., Frank Abercrombie, S. C. Carson, Charles F. James, and Calvin Rampey.

The meeting was called to order by the mayor, G. M. Perry, and the first thing that was brought up to the attention of the council members was the property and personal taxes that are due ~~May 1~~, June 1, 1951, which will be before another council meeting takes place. Mr. Perry suggested that they wait until we get the total taxations before setting the mills for the 1951 taxes. As all the council members know we have already borrowed \$3,000.00 from the mill on their 1951 taxes. We also have to pay \$9,280 for bond and interest before the next ~~year~~ tax year.

Mr. Perry asked Mr. Gaines to give a report on the sewer. Mr. Gaines said that everyone had been very nice and all were connected except John Kelley, D. Mann and a tenant house at Mrs. S. R. Kelley and the one at L. S. Griffen. D. Mann has started his sewer but it isn't finished. An ordinance will have to be made concerning oil going into the sewer lines. It kills all the bacteria. The sewer committee will take charge of this and go see all the stations, and work out something to relieve this oil.
