

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

MAY 12, 1975

Those Present: Councilmen Fowler, Hopkins, Thompson, Porter. St. Supervisor John Head, Chief Duncan, & Mayor Holladay. Catherine Hughes Town Clerk. J.D. Corn, Greenville News Reporter.

Mayor called the meeting to order stated that RSS Planned Use Report needed to be filled in and mailed by June 1, 1975.

J.D. Corn former policemen for the Town of Central came before the council to render his apology for previous behavior while on duty. "He said," he knew that he had let the council down and was very sorry; that each one had been nice to him. Corn stated if ever he could be of any service he would be happy to do whatever he could. The Chief of Police, Mayor, & Town Council accepted this apology with gratitude.

Mayor stated that Chief Duncan had registered a protest against beer license for Ray's Recreation.

Mayor stated he had been approached by Rev. Waddell concerning painting the underpass. Waddell's offer was if town furnish the paint he would see that this was taken care of. Motion made and seconded Council approved on the above offer.

The matter concerning the ceiling in the meeting room was discussed and felt that this was a necessity to be repaired.

Mayor stated that the Month of May being set aside for clean up for the Town of Central needed to be boosted and asked Chief to help in this matter concerning cleaning at the back of the stores starting with his first.

St. Supervisor John Head ask the question concerning holes in the streets what to fill with. Council felt that asphalt was best.

Motion made by Fowler, seconded by Hopkins to purchase weed & mosquito killer. Council approved.

State Firemen's Convention Council approved at an early date.

Motion by Thompson, seconded by Hopkins to have problem with the backhoe repaired. Council approved.

Motion by Fowler, seconded by Hopkins to purchase a Scout Sampler for the North Treatment Plant. Council approved.

Discussion was made concerning parking at Sonny's Drive Inn, Chief of Police was asked to work on this matter.

Problems with dogs was in discussion, Mayor Holladay was to talk to the Dog Catcher.

Porter stated that the comfort stations were under constructions and should be final in about a 2 weeks. Cost approx. \$2500 or \$3000

Motion By: Fowler, 2nd by Hopkins that the office, meeting room, & police dept. be painted. Cost not to exceed \$150. Council approved.

Mayor stated to the council that business license & ordinances needed to be updated.

Thompson stated to the council that their needed a fence at the upper side of the Central Park to keep cars, motor-cycles off the grass. No final action was taken on this matter.

Thompson stated that the gates at the upper side of the park needed to be open for children coming from the upper side of town. Mayor said he would talk with the Chief and get his men to take care of this matter.


John! When water is off at the park lock the restrooms.


Summer office employee was brought before the council. (Tersa Newton) same as last year will be available. Council approved
