MINUTES

MAY 20, 1974

REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING

Those Present: Fowler, Hopkins, Kenemore, O'Dell, Thompson, Mayor Holladay, East Clemson Water District Members, Leland Brock, Roy Dillard.

Meeting with the council and presented a complaint was Mr. Roy Dillard if the property in which he owned was inside the city limits he would like police protection & garbage pick up.

Mayor asked the committee to report on the increased water rates for the Town of Central, Glen O'Dell acted as spokesman for this committee, recommended to the council a 36% increase, same as Easley Central over the Town. Motion made by Fowler, seconded by Hopkins that we adopt these rates. Council voted unanimously.

Fowler stated that Pratt Read & Co. he felt should be treated on the outside basis. Motion by O'Dell, seconded by Fowler that Pratt Read be increased to 48%. Council voted unanimously.

Also meeting with the council were the members of the East Clemson Water District concerning the rate increase, all from this district were agreeable with the rates.

Mayor Holladay was asked to explain to the Highway 88 Water District the rate increase.

Meeting with council was Mr. Leland Brock discussing the possibility of a Centennial since the Town would be 100 years old in March 1975. No action taken in this matter, to be brought before the council at a later date.

Mayor stated that Revenue Sharing was up about \$6,000 over last years allocations.

Mayor stated the sewer project was near finalization and the audit prepared by Ozie Garrett almost complete.

Motion by O'Dell, seconded by Hopkins for John Head to hire two boys for the summertime help, also (2) lawn mowers for the St. Dept. approved.

Motion made by Thompson, seconded by O'Dell to donate the white police car to the Central Fire Dept. Motion carried.

No futher business was transacted at this meeting.
