At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council, of The Town of Central, Central, South Carolina; held in the Town Office Wednesday night, June 1, 1949 at 7:30 P.M. were: Hon. G. M. Perry, Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police, Councilmen: T. A. Phillips, J. A. Mauldin, Furman Hopkins, Grady Sanders, Herman Sanders, and R. A. Busha.

General Business matters were discussed which included, the buying of a power mower* to cut grass at the Cemetery. It was moved by T. A. Phillips and seconded by J. A. Mauldin, and voted by all for Mr. Perry and Mr. Gaines to go ahead and buy the Mower*.

A resolution was passed-- It was moved by R. A. Busha and seconded by Herman Sanders that all dogs should be inoculated and that after June 15, 1949 any dog found running loose and not muzzled or displaying a tag of inoculation will be killed by the Chief of Police or any other officer of the Town.

A few other business matters were discussed after which the meeting adjourned.
