The Town Council met Thursday night, June 3, 1965, with the following attending: Mayor W.C. Kelley, Councilmen Glenn D. O'Dell, R.A. Busha, J.R. Herd, W.J. Wilson, Jerry Lesley, Mrs. Maude Chapman, reporter for the Messenger Paper was also present.

Mayor W.C. Kelley presided over the meeting. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Futher discussion was held on installing a fire hydrant at the Corner of Eaton & Kennemore Streets. Mayor Kelley stated that the 600 feet of water pipe had been ordered for the extension of water line for the fire hydrant.

Property for new type lagoons for sewer system were discussed. Mr. Kelley appointed Councilmen O'Dell, Lesley, Busha and himself to talk with William Wallace and Cannon Mills about property which would be suitable for these lagoons.

Councilman Lesley made a motion that the Town employees be given ~~xx~~ \$60.00 as a bonus for vacation. Councilman O'Dell seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Councilman Herd made a motion that the Masons be allowed to tap the Masonic building on the to the water and sewerage at the same price as churches have been allowed to do which is ~~xxxx~~ pay the cost of installing taps. Councilman Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Councilman Lesley made a motion that the extra Fire Truck which has been purchased by the fire Dept. be used to sprinkle grass on the ~~xxxxxx~~ newly seeded ball field at the park during dry weather. Councilman Herd seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Being no futher business the meeting adjourned.
