The Town Council met Thursday night, June 4, 1964, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, W.J. Wilson, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin and Mrs. Maude Chapman, representing the Messenger Paper.

Mayor Cranford presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

Mayor Cranford announced that a meeting opposing another liquor store in the Town of Central would be held in Columbia on June 25th.

A discussion was held on having Town Ordinances printed in Book Form. No action was taken on this.

Mr. Busha & Mr. Wilson announced that they had met with Miss Amanda Patterson and A.R. Cureton, Earl Crane, property owners who would like to be taken into the Town limits. No action was taken on this other than plans to meet with these property owners on Wednesday afternoon, June 10th for further discussion.

Mr. Wilson said that John Head had contacted him about the Fire Hydrants needing painting & flushing. The Council agreed for John to paint the top and valves of Fire Hydrants Aluminum and to flush hydrants. Mr. Martin mentioned that the Street markers were in need of being painted.

Mr. Bryan made a motion that the Town Clerk's expenses be paid to Columbia on June 11th to attend Finance Officers School. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Busha mentioned that Johnny Sanders had contacted him about signs near his home where children are playing to control the speed of motorists.

Mr. Wilson stated that Mr. E.L. Bolick had requested that a street light be installed near his home in Kel-Car Acres. Mr. Wilson made a motion that this light be installed. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned.
