June 5, 1961

The Town Council met Monday night June 5, 1961 with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, J.J. Canup, J.A. Cranford, W.J. Wilson, H.M. Brooks and Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger Paper.

Mayor Carson presided. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved.

An Ordinance to change the Fiscal year for the purpose of collecting Town Taxes in the Town of Central, was read by each Councilmen and approved.

A discussion was held on extending the sewer line on Wesleyan Drive. Mr. Carson stated that Beeson Engineering Co. had checked the sewage line and reported that there was not enough fall for the line to be extended.

A discussion was held on naming the streets through the Housing Project. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the street through the Housing Project be named McDaniel St. the one on the East side of Housing Project be named Dunwoody Ave. Mr. Canup seconded the motion.

A discussion was held on riding bicycles on the streets and displaying goods on the streets. The Council decided to see what the results would be by having this published in the paper before any action was taken.

Vacations for the Waterworks employes was discussed. Mr. Cranford made a motion that Mr. Moser and Mr. Goldson work something out among themselves as they did last year. Mr. Busha seconded the motion.

Mr. Canup made a motion that the City Clerk's expenses be paid to the municipal meeting in Columbia on June 27, 1961. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion.

The Council discussed doing something for the Deputies since they have been so nice in helping in the Town. No definite decision was made.

Mr. Cranford made a motion that there be no meeting in July. The Council agreed.
