The Town Council met Thursday night, June 6, 1963, with the following attending: Mayor J.A. Cranford, Councilmen, C.B. Bryan, R.A. Busha, J.L. Martin, W.J. Wilson, H.M. Brooks, A.R. Cureton, Mr. Gibson, Supt. of Easley-Central Water Dist. and Mrs. Maude Chapman representing the Messenger and Bob Bradley representing the Greenville News were also present.

Mr. Gibson, said the Easley-Central Water District would like to lease the Central Filter Plant to use in case of an emergency at a nominal fee of \$1.00 per year. He also stated that he would like to read meters, do installations and any maintenance the Town would have concerning the water works. No action was taken on these.

The Volunteer Firemen attending the State Convention in Columbia was discussed. Mr. Brooks made a motion that each Firemen (as many as three) attending the convention be paid \$30.00 for expense. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Martin mentioned that a Fire Nozzle was needed for the Fire Dept. and made a motion that the Town purchase one. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Insurance for the old Panel truck which was given to the Civil Defense by the Town was discussed and also tags for the truck. Mr. Wilson made a motion that the Town bear the expense of the insurance provided it did not exceed \$40.00 and purchase tags for truck. Mr. Busha seconded the motion.

Increasing the water rates for Cannon Mills and Pratt Road Companies were discussed. Mr. Brooks made a motion that the two plants pay .28 per thousand instead of .22 per thousand. Mr. Busha seconded the motion. The council agreed.

Mr. Reams mentioned that the Town Jail was in bad need of paint, light fixtures and bunks. The Council agreed that this repair was needed and ask that Mr. Reams check on old metal doors and bunks at County Jail in Anderson and have the painting done.

Mr. Cranford mentioned that I.O. Evatt had ask the Town to fix the curb for his driveway to the Washerette. The Council decided that it would be left up to the Hwy. Dept. to do this for him.

Mr. Brooks made a motion that the Town purchase some stop signs which are badly needed in various parts of town. Mr. Busha seconded the motion.


A traffic light for the stop near the Drug Store was discussed but no decision made.
