At the regular monthly meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Central held Wednesday night May 3, 1950 at 7 o'clock P. M. were: G. M. Perry, Mayor, W. A. Gaines, Chief of Police, J. A. Maulding, R. A. Busha, Herman Sanders and Furman Hopkins.

Mr. Perry had received a letter from Dr. Mullinax at the Wesleyan College wanting to use our fire hose and equipment in case of fire at the College. It was agreed by all that Mr. Perry write Dr. Mullinax that he may use our equipment at any time it is necessary.

The taxes were discussed and Mr. Perry had a list of our expenses for the year and the Council decided to put on 35 mills this year. 10 mills will be to run the town and 25 mills to pay off bonds & interest.

J. A. Maulding moved and R. A. Busha seconded it for the taxes to be raised to 35 mills. It was agreed by all present.

After which the Council adjourned.
