The Town Council met Thursday night, June 7, 1962, with the following attending: Mayor S.C. Carson, Councilmen C.B. Bryan, J.A. Cranford, H.M. Brooks, J.J. Canup, R.A. Busha, W.J. Wilson, Mr. L.O. Evatt with the volunteer Fire Dept. and Mrs. Maude Chapman with the Messenger Paper.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved. Mr. Bryan made a motion that the minutes be adopted, Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council approved.

The Mayor and Town Council talked with Mr. Evatt about the responsibility of taking the fire calls during the day. Mr. Evatt said that he would be glad to stay on as a volunteer fireman but would like for someone else to be responsible for the calls during the day. Mr. Evatt said that he would answer the calls until someone else took his place.

Mr. Wilson gave a report on the street light which had been requested by J.D. Walker. Mr. Brooks made a motion that a light be installed at the North West Corner of Mr. Walker's home in which a pole would also have to be erected. Mr. Bryan seconded the motion. The Council agreed.

Mr. Reams gave a report on a small lawn mower which he was given permission to buy for the Town to be used to cut grass in small areas which the tractor could not do.

Mr. Busha made a motion that someone with equipment be hired to install a new water line to Central Dry Cleaners. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. Council agreed.

Mr. Wilson and Mr. Carson gave a report on their trip to the municipal meeting held at Myrtle Beach.

Mr. Wilson made a motion that the clerk's expense be paid to the Clerk's school to be held at the University of South Carolina on June 19th. The amount to be \$20.00. Mr. Cranford seconded the motion. The Council agreed.
